<b>Competition Method</b>	Pools of 3 – 6 Players Players are placed in pools according to age, weight and ability (as best we can with information given it is not possible for all pools to be perfectly matched) 6 pools every 50 minutes or so from 9.30 am.
<b>Medals</b>	Every Player receives a medal – Gold, Silver or Bronze A spirit of Judo award is also presented to one player from each pool Medals presented as pools finish
<b>Clubs</b>	There will be a trophy presented for the club that submits the most competitors
<b>Coaching</b>	Due to this being a friendly event, <b>STRICTLY no coaching at matside! General encouragement only</b> Spectator encouragement to players is encouraged, as this creates a good atmosphere
<b>Friendly</b>	We hope to provide a friendly but competitive inter- club competition, in which the children/players come first. Please remember that these events are organised for young or reasonably inexperienced players to gain confidence and self-esteem. <b>Main stream competition medal winners should NOT be entered</b>
